

# Gatineau Riverfest September 7, 2019

## Flotilla and Shuttle Instructions between Wakefield and Chelsea



The Flotilla starts at 2PM sharp so make sure you give yourself lots of time to park, register and shuttle. Life jackets and marine safety kits are mandatory.

The shuttle for Flotilla participants will run between : Farm Point Park in Chelsea (311 Chemin de la riviere) and the Registration Booth at Turntable Parkin Wakefield ( 805 Riverside ) between 12:15pm and 2:30pm.

We request that Flotilla participants follow this procedure (see maps below for additional information):

If you have a water craft

- Drive to Wakefield with your watercraft and park at Turntable Park (just north of Wakefield General Store)
- Register/check in at the registration booth in Turntable Park
  
- Drop your boat beside the Wakefield registration booth. Non-drivers can stay with the watercraft in Wakefield but we will have people on hand to watch the watercrafts
- Drivers will drive their car (without watercraft) to the parking areas at the Farm Point Park
- Drivers take the shuttle from the Farm Point Park back up to their watercraft, and people in their group in Wakefield.

If you are renting from Expedition Wakefield

- Drive and park at Farm Point Park
- Register / check in at the registration booth in Farm Point
- Take the shuttle to Expedition Wakefield in Wakefield
- Get your watercraft in the the water and paddle north to Turntable park to join the Flotilla

If you are in the dragon boat

- Drive and park at Farm Point Park
- Register / check in at the registration booth in Farm Point
- Take the shuttle to Turntable Park in Wakefield
- Hop in the dragon boat to join the flotilla

Please note:

- The shuttle is for those people who have registered and paid for the Flotilla
- We do not shuttle boats/watercraft, just people (and preferably just the drivers)
- River/Riverside Rd. between the event in Farm Point and Wakefield will be blocked-off in front of the Farm Point Community Centre. **Accordingly, when driving between Wakefield and the event in Chelsea (Farm Point) you will need to take ch. St. Clément and highway 105.**

**Parking in Wakefield (start of Flotilla):**

When you are dropping off your watercraft in Wakefield, temporarily use the parking at or north of Turntable park). Please DO NOT park at any of the private businesses parking lots (e.g., Wakefield General Store)

**Parking at Farm Point Community Centre (event site):**

Please park at Farm Point Park at 311 Chemin de la riviere before stopping at the registration booth.

**Take-out point for Flotilla paddlers (event site):**

When arriving by river at the event, we ask paddlers to take out at the community dock that is just downstream from the event and across from the parking lot at ch. 311 de la rivière (outdoor hockey rink). Then come and join us at the festival!!
